Learn Breton Language and Culture

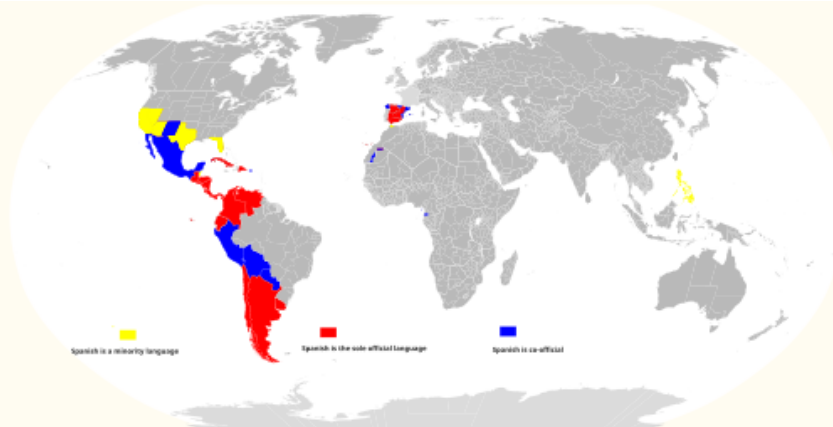
