Se drēam is cræft, þe ge spæg ge stilnysse biþ.

Drēam mæg man mid missenlīcum gomenpudum and stefnum drēman. Sind mænigfealdlice cynn, spilce þā folclīcan drēamas, þā geþýpe drēamas, drēamcræft, and þā godcundan drēamas.

Þæt word *drēam* on Ænglisc is fram Þeodisce (Traum) gelæded. In Nīpenglisc brýcaþ man þæt word *music*, þe is fram Crēacisce (μουσική οὐδὲ mousike; "cræft þāra elfena").^[1]
