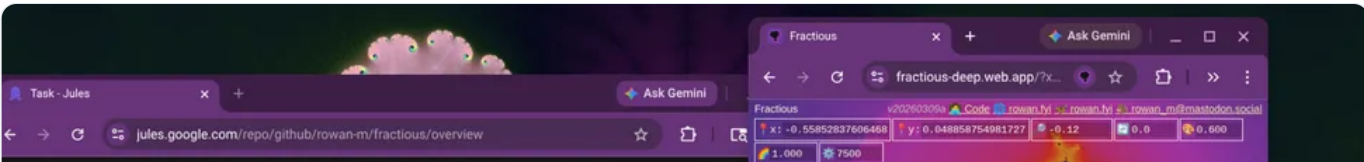

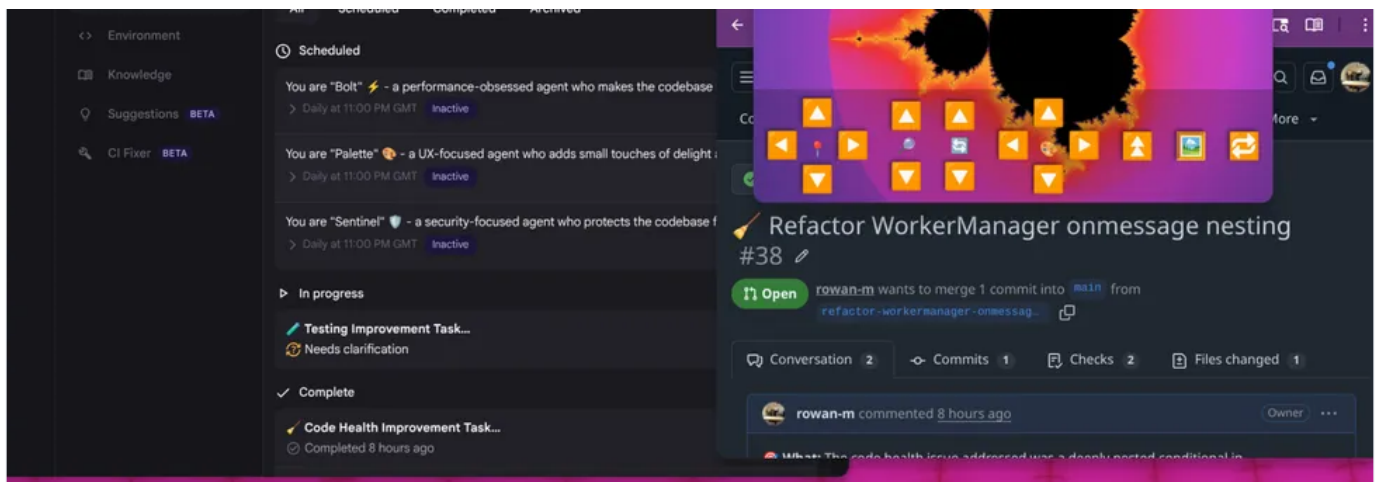

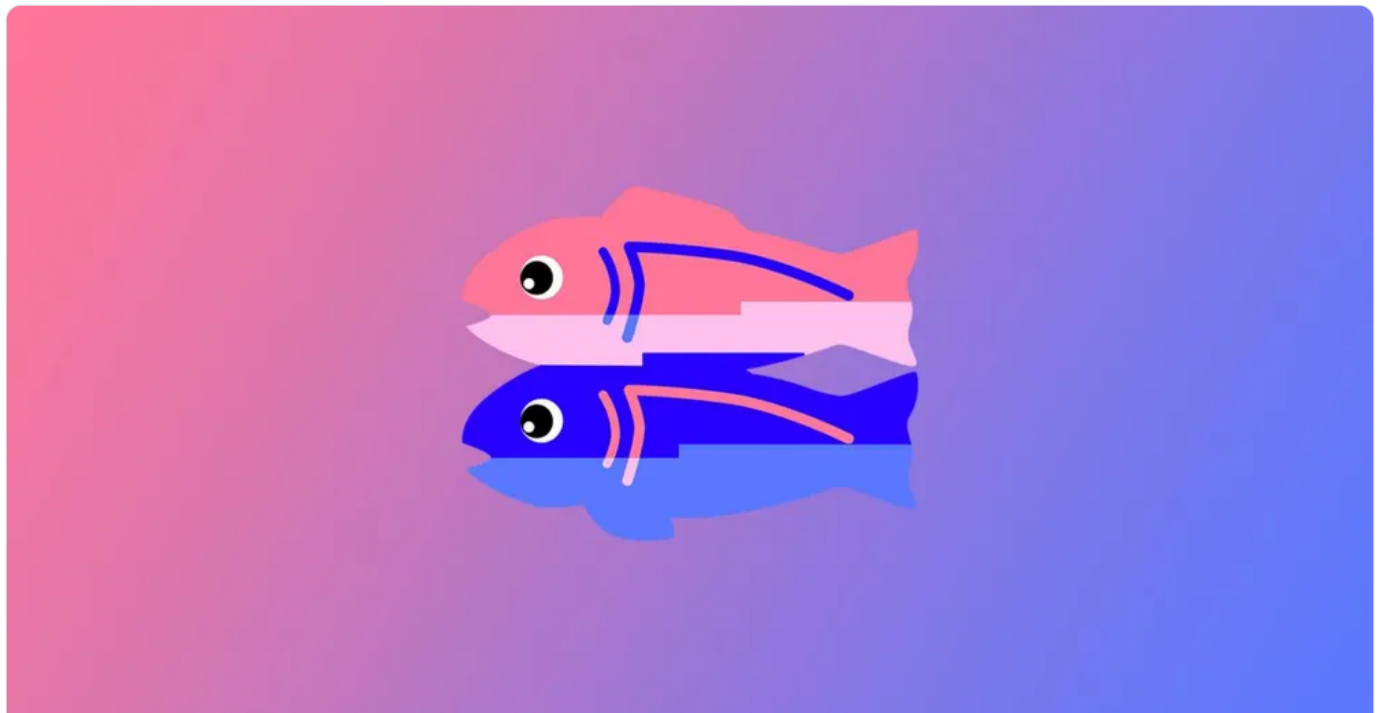

📱 Safari ships CHIPS! (AKA Cookies Having Independent Partitioned State)

Where you currently use `requestStorageAccess()` for third-party cookies but that cookie isn't used on multiple sites - CHIPS might work. CHIPS means no user prompt as it's a much safer, tighter scope.
