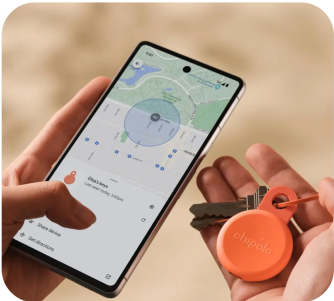


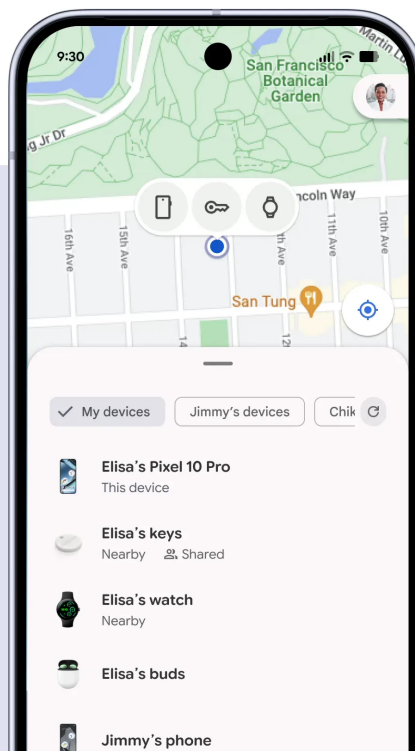

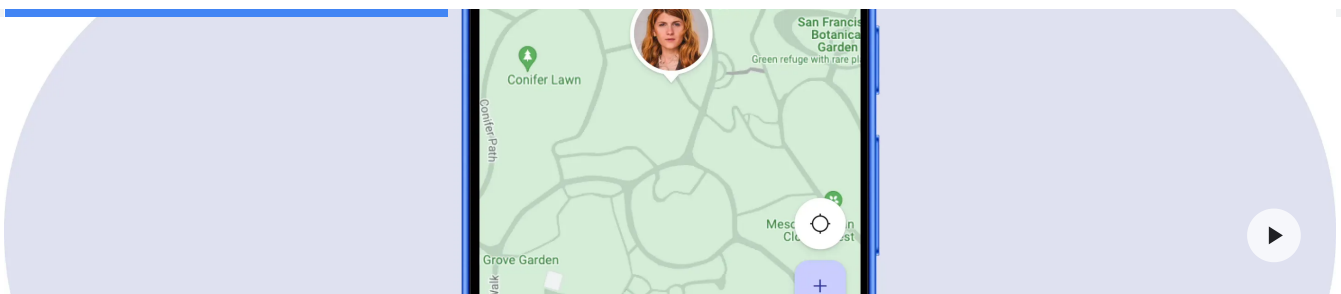

Device location data on the Find Hub network is encrypted using the PIN, pattern, or password for your Android device.⁵

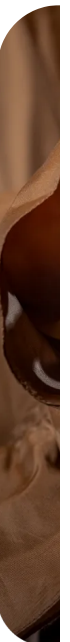
Secure, lock, or erase from anywhere.
