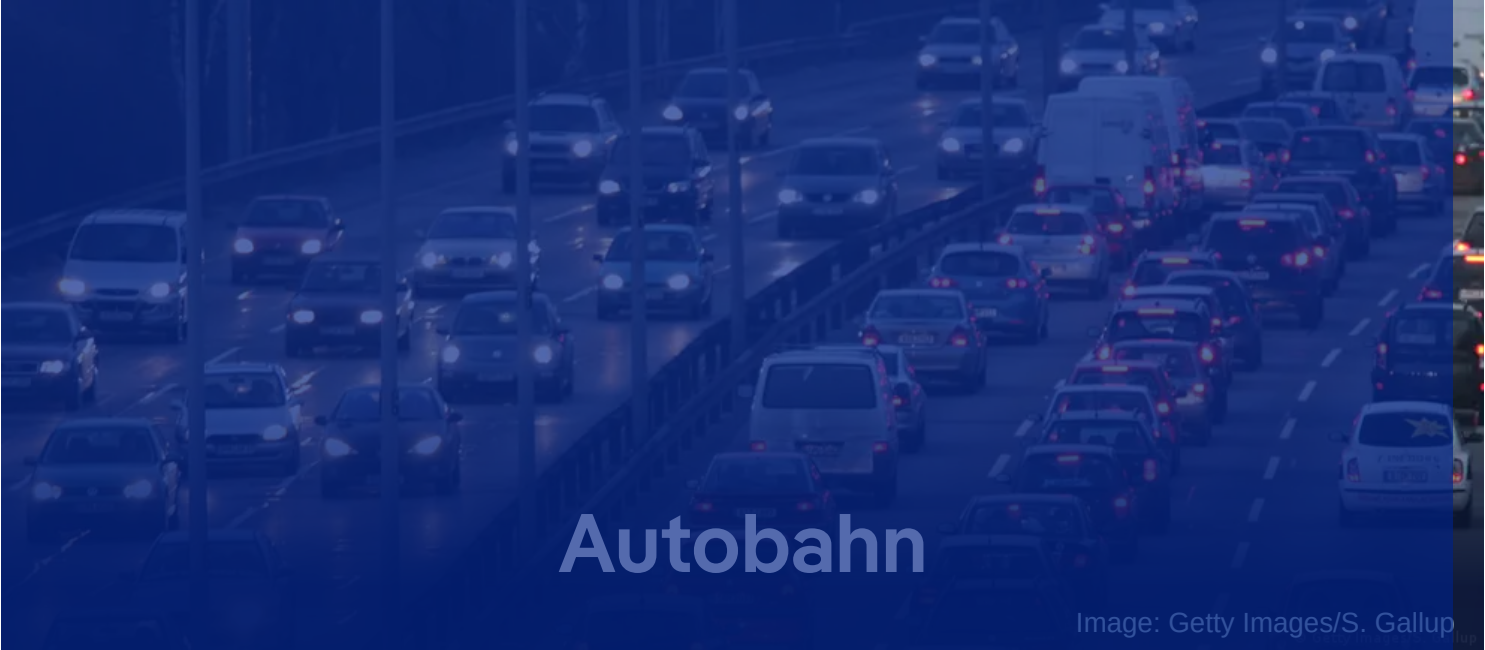




Autobahn
