Shehbaz Sharif serves as the prime minister of Pakistan, having assumed office for a second term in 2024 after previously holding the position from 2022 to 2023.

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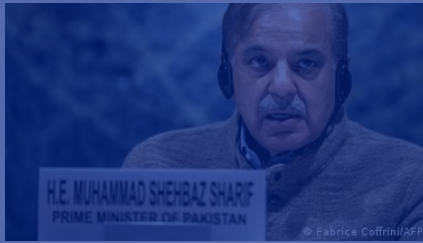
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
