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teig-lach  (tāg lă ' , tīg -)

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pl.n. (used with a sing. or pl. verb)

A confection consisting of rounded bits of dough cooked briefly in a honey syrup and sometimes mixed with nuts or candied fruit.

[Yiddish *teyglekh*, from *teygl*, diminutive of *teyg*, dough, from Middle High German *teig*, from Old High German *teic*; see **dheigh-** in the Appendix of Indo-European roots.]

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
