A seasoned purée of Provençal origin prepared from salted cod, olive oil, milk or cream, and sometimes potatoes.

[French, from Provençal *brandado*, from Old Provençal , past participle of *brandar*, to shake, from *bran*, sword, of Germanic origin; see **g^wher-** in the Appendix of Indo-European roots.]

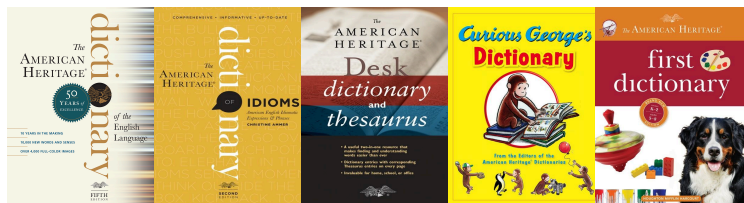
