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Har-dy  (här dē), **G(odfrey) H(arold)** 1877-1947.

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British mathematician noted for his work in number theory, his book *A Mathematician's Apology* (1940), and his collaboration with Srinivasa Ramanujan.

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Hardy, Thomas 1840-1928.

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British writer whose pessimistic outlook on life is expressed in novels like *Tess of the d'Urbervilles* (1891) and poems like "The Convergence of the Twain" (1912).

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Hardy, Oliver Originally **Norvell Hardy**. 1892-1957.

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American comedian famous for the slapstick films he made with his partner Stan Laurel, including *The Music Box* (1932) and *Way Out West* (1937).
