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**co·deine**  (kō dēn', -dē-ĭn)

An alkaloid narcotic,  $C_{18}H_{21}NO_3$ , derived from opium or morphine and used as a cough suppressant, analgesic, and hypnotic.

[French *codéine* : Greek *kōdeia*, poppy head (from *kōos*, cavity; see **keua-** [in the Appendix of Indo-European roots](#)) + -*ine*, alkaloid; see [-INE](#)<sup>2</sup>.]

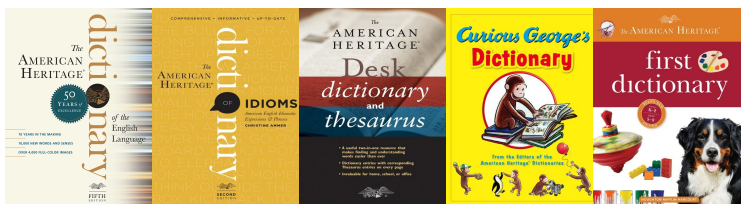
