VS.

emperor

- has hereditary rule and absolute power of an empire (larger geographical area than a kingdom)
- a female leader is called an *empress*

UAP

- unidentified anomalous phenomena
- used in scientific research and formal discussion



VS.

UFO

- unidentified flying objects
- defines something in the air that's unknown, not necessarily something that's from another world

nepo baby



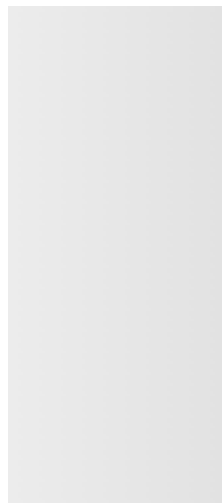
- someone who is treated better overall in their careers due to their parent or parents being famous or successful
- implies that this person is not as gifted as others, but was granted success by their family instead
- sometimes used to describe the child of a celebrity, regardless of their success or skills

Jack Quaid might be a nepo baby, but he's so talented!



"Nepo Baby": Meaning and Origin

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psychopath

a trait noun that refers to those who outwardly display psychopathy (lack of guilt, empathy, responsibility, the guidance of a conscience, or anxiety, as well as a tendency to be attention-seeking)

VS.

sociopath

a trait noun that once was used in the same way as psychopath, but is now primarily used as an insult to exaggerate someone's mental illness or to emphasize one's harmful actions in society

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"Psychopath" vs. "Sociopath": What Do the Terms Actually Mean?

peace of mind

- means “serenity of thoughts and feelings”
- used to define a feeling someone is experiencing after overcoming or avoiding stress



VS.

piece of mind

- a common misspelling of *peace of mind*
- used correctly in the idiom *give someone a piece of my mind*



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Is It "Piece of Mind" or "Peace of Mind"?

one in the same

- means "the same in the same"
- a misuse of *one* and *the same*



VS.

one and the same

- means "the same thing" or "the same person"
- often used to emphasize or highlight the similarities between two separate things or people



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Is It "One and the Same" or "One in the Same"?

Barbecue **VS.** Barbeque

barbecue the original spelling for “a grill, pit, or outdoor fireplace for roasting meat” or “a social gathering, usually held outdoors, at which food is cooked over an open flame”

barbeque an incorrect but now acceptable alternate spelling of “barbecue”

pushing P



a malleable phrase that can be used however the speaker wants, including:

- to mean “keeping it real,” “being authentic,” or “being positive”
- to flaunt your wealth, spend large amounts of money, or pull in a significant wage



What's the Real Meaning of "Pushing P"?

yeet

- (verb) to toss something
- (verb) to fly through the air with a lot of force
- (verb) to hang out
- (verb) to rush around
- (interjection) “Wow!” or “Boo yah!”

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What Does "Yeet" Actually Mean?

et al.

- an abbreviation for the Latin *et alia*, meaning “and others”
- always indicates a continuation of a list of people



vs.

etc.

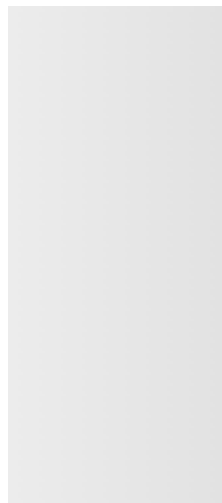
- an abbreviation of the Latin *et cetera*, meaning “and the rest”
- indicates a longer list of items

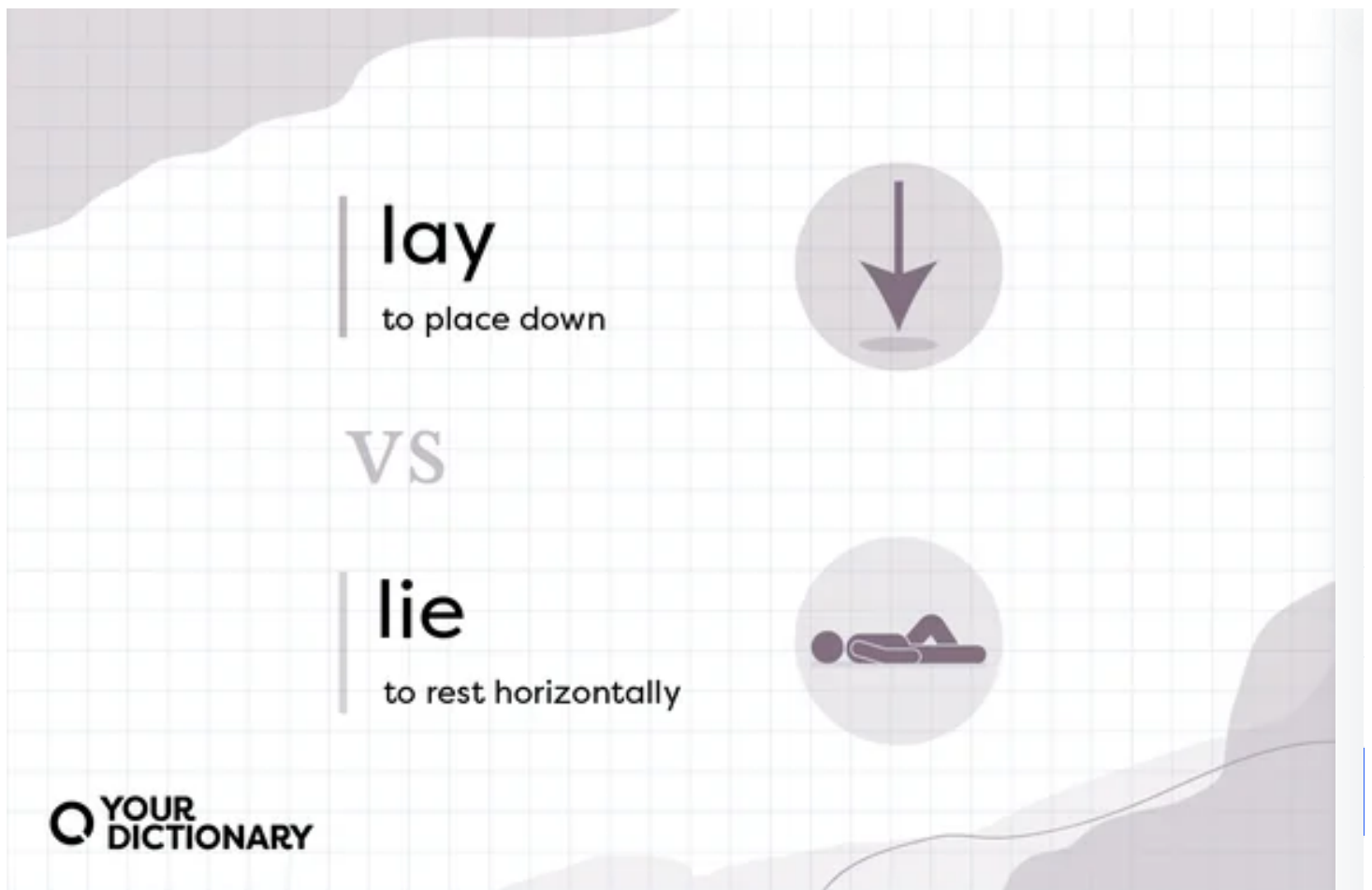

deep-seated

“firmly implanted” or “lying deep beneath the surface”



VS.

deep-seeded

planting seeds deep underground
